



HELPFUL TIPS FOR AWESOME ATTENDANCE

- Remind your child that school is their first and most important job!
- Communicate the importance of regular school attendance to your child so they are hearing the same thing we are saying at school.
- If your child has a doctor/ dentist appointment, they can still get credit for a full day if they attend at least half of the day. You can bring them before or after their appointment with the note from the doctor.
- If your student is running a fever of 100 degrees or more, vomiting, or has diarrhea they need to be kept home--if they do not have any of these symptoms, please send them!

ATTENDANCE MATTERS

Missing Just 2 Days Per Month Can Affect Your Academic Success!



18 OR MORE DAYS

- Excused and unexcused absences represent lost time in the classroom and lost opportunities to learn.
- Missing just one day every two weeks can add up to 18 days in a year. Absences add up before you even know it.



10 TO 17 DAYS

- Students who are absent an average of 15 days a year miss a year's worth of school before their senior year.
- When students miss a day of school it actually puts them two days behind their classmates.



9 OR FEWER ABSENCES

- Students with good attendance generally achieve higher grades and enjoy school more.
- Children benefit and make the most of their educational opportunities if they attend school regularly and on time.
